LOGLINE

Young Samir is in love and sees himself torn between his family in Morocco and his dream of a brighter future in Europe.

SHORT SYNOPSIS

Samir longs for love and fights for better perspectives in a country of limited opportunities. He believes a brighter future awaits him abroad. For his new love, will he leave Morocco behind and start afresh in Europe? Samir's inner conflict involves his whole family.

LONG SYNOPSIS

Inside Marrakech's bustling Medina, Samir is looking for love and a brighter future. But his summer flings all come to a bitter end at the airport and he is left behind in a country with limited possibilities.

When Samir really falls in love, he is faced with a major decision: Should he listen to his sisters and agree to an arranged marriage in Morocco? Or should he follow his love and his dream of a brighter future in Europe?

DIRECTORS STATEMENT

Marriage to a foreigner is tantamount to a visa for Europe, and many young Moroccans see it as the key to happiness. But such relationships are usually tainted with prejudices and clichés. And that's where I wanted to start and take a closer look. LOVE WILL COME LATER tells the story from the Moroccan perspective and makes it possible to experience what it means to have to wait for your beloved without being able to simply hop across the border yourself, or how it feels to have to let your son go to Europe. And what turmoil arises when the desire to leave means separation from the family. With the intimate portrait of a young Moroccan, my film deals with the complexity of love, perspectives and cultural ideas in a globalized world.

After completing her Bachelor Degree at the Lucerne University of Applied Sciences, Design & Art in the Department of Video in 2015 with distinction, Julia Furer received the Förderpreis award of the Zeugindesign Foundation for her graduation film JULIAN. The film has since been awarded various prizes and has been shown, among others, at the Karlovy Vary International Film Festival in 2016. She worked for several production companies and as a freelance sound engineer and director. With her first feature LOVE WILL COME LATER she accomplished her master degree in directing documentaries at the University of the arts Zurich ZHdK. LOVE WILL COME LATER was nominated for the OPERA PRIMA at the Solothurn Film Festival 2022. The film was awarded with the Swiss Film Award 2022 as Best Graduation Film.





THOMAS RECHBERGER





Thomas is a Swiss musician, music producer and sounddesigner. He has been working as an audio pro on all sides of the microphon for more than 20 years: As the lead guitarist of the band Lovebugs he has played more than 1'000 concerts in Europe, recorded 13 albums including several Nr.1 records and awards. Thomas is also a passionate music producer and the founder of Alterna Recording Studios - a vibrating spot for Switzerland's alternative music scene . In recent years the focus of his work has shiftet towards audio in film where Thomas works in projects as a sounddesigner, composer and mixer for documentaries, commercials and feature film.

Since 2015 Thomas got his hands on around 20 different 360°-projects where he is maximizing presence and immersion of 3D-soundscapes. He collaborates with SRF, ZHdK and "Bandara", Switzerland's leading company for VR-content.
